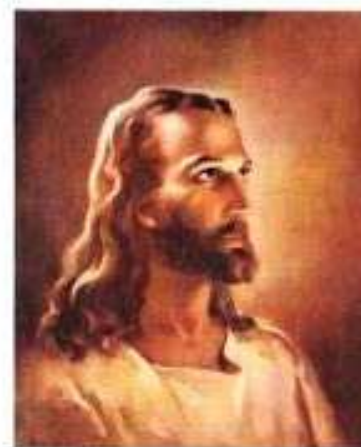

All items in our store are donated by members of our community. Most of our clothing is given free to people in need. Our simple application process allows us to learn more about our customers' needs and gives us the opportunity to encourage them through the sharing of God's Word. Applicants are allowed to receive five free outfits for each child in their household every six months and five free outfits per year for adults.

For those who are able to pay, we request a donation of \$2 for pants, \$1 for tops and modest donations for all other items. Our Food Ministries

We are currently serving up to 25 families per week through our food pantry, and the need for food assistance continues to rise. The supply of food in each bag is prayed over and carefully sorted out to provide balanced nutrition for a family of four for two days.

We recently began offering free lunches every weekday at noon through our soup kitchen. Most days these are hot, homemade meals, and we currently serve an average of 20 people per day.
